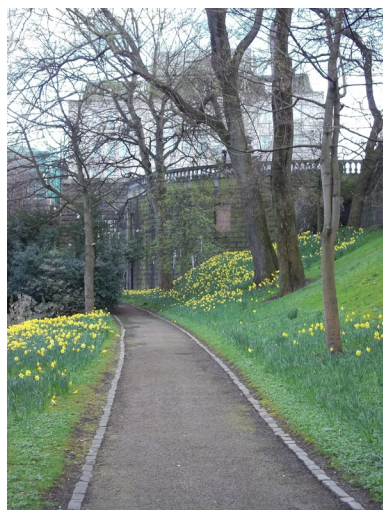
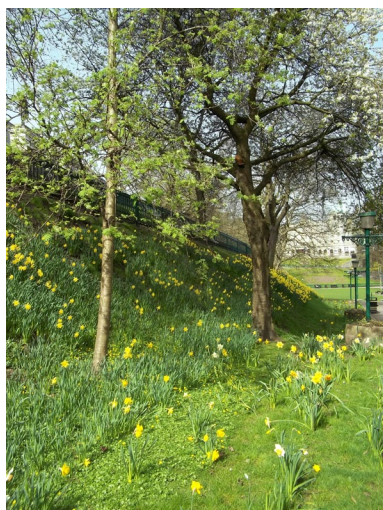




Retain Union Terrace Gardens
